The New Suffragan See of Lynn


Many were delighted when the Queen honoured the diocese of Norwich by her approval of the creation of the new Suffragan See of Lynn, thus giving us the benefit of the services of a third bishop.

The Bishop of Norwich, Dr. Launcelot Fleming, announced that the Archdeacon of Lynn had been chosen to be the first Bishop of Lynn. The Archdeacon of Norfolk had also been chosen to fill the recently vacated See at Thetford. The Bishop of Thetford, the Rt. Rev. E. W. B. Cordingly, came to the diocese in 1962 from Stevenage. The Bishop of Lynn, the Rt. Rev. W. S. Llewellyn, came to the diocese in 1961 from Tetbury, in Gloucestershire, where he was Rural Dean.

The two new bishops were consecrated in Westminster Abbey on St. Luke's Day (October 18th) last year by the Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr. Michael Ramsey. I was privileged enough to witness the ceremony.
